We have organized a workshop to help early-career researchers strengthen their oral presentation and science communication skills. The workshop, titled “**Storytelling for Researchers**”, will be led by **Mirko Bischofberger** from **Science Studios**.

Audience: The **1st Swiss Early Career Psychologist Network (SECPN) Early Career Researcher Day** is aimed at PhD students and postdocs from all fields of psychology who are enrolled at or working for a University or University of Applied Sciences in Switzerland.

Goal: The event offers early-career researchers the opportunity to further develop their research competences, expand their professional network, and engage with international experts. The workshop will focus on scientific storytelling and communication, combining storytelling techniques, writing strategies, media interaction, social media communication, and engagement with policymakers.

Programme

Morning: Foundations of effective scientific storytelling, including core principles, narrative techniques, and writing strategies to ensure clarity and impact.

Afternoon: An applied session on adapting messages to different audiences and formats, such as the media, social media, lay audiences, and policymakers, with practical exercises.

Language: English.

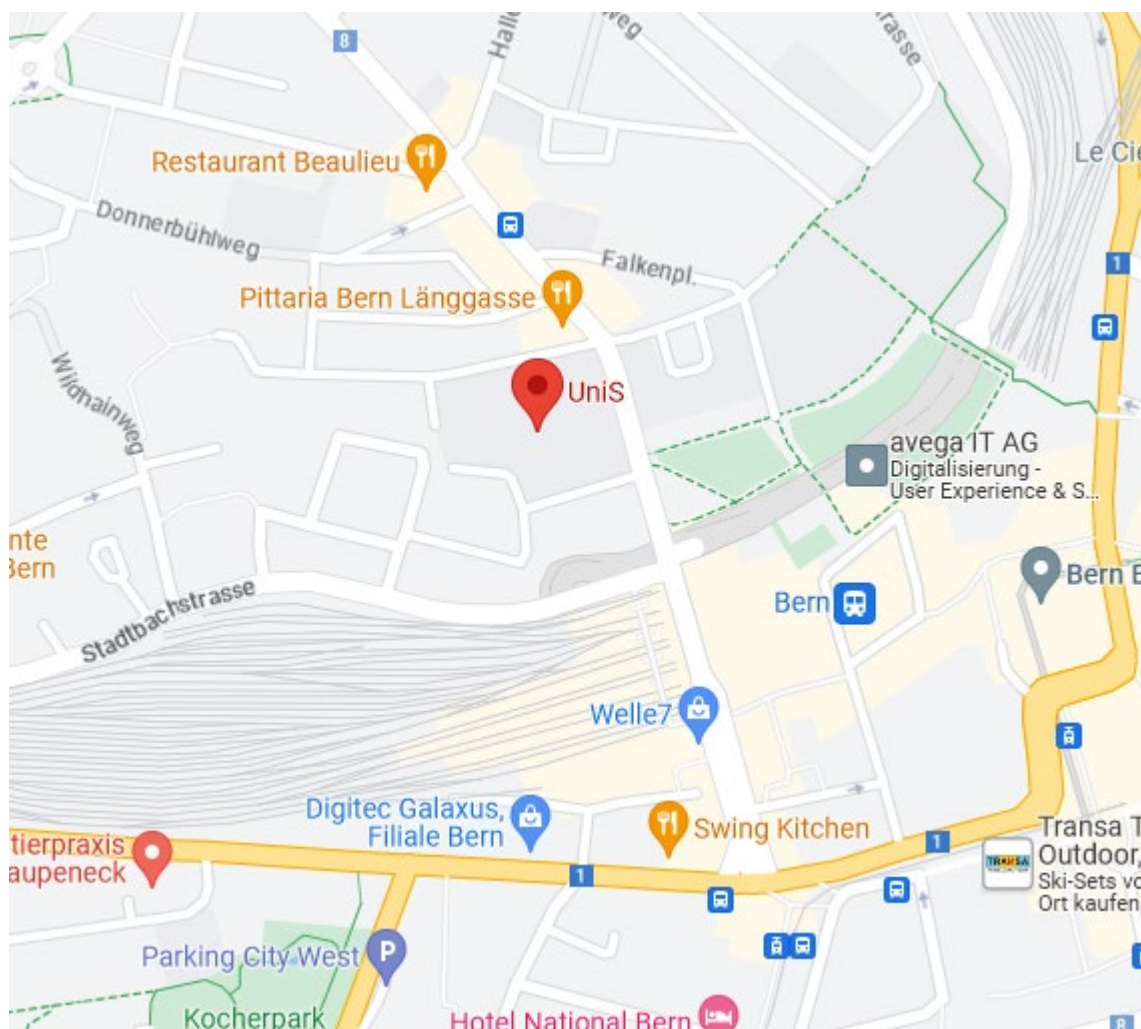
